

## RETURN TO WORK STUDY PARTICIPANTS WANTED

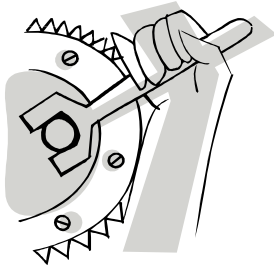

- Have experience as a union or employee representative advocating for injured workers

If you have not worked for at least 5 years in Ontario or do not have competent communication skills in English you do not meet the criteria for participation in this study.
