The Oasis in Kanata is a community outreach program of Glen Cairn United Church that offers information, education, and support for caregivers of people with mental illness living in Kanata and the surrounding area.

We are inviting artists to donate to our first art fundraiser by contributing sketches, drawings, collages, photographs, and paintings that explore the resilience caregivers embody and nurture in their loved ones. Resilience can be depicted in many different ways and we encourage you to interpret resilience in a way that is unique to you: in landscapes, portraits, abstracts, etc. All funds raised during the exhibit will be donated to The Oasis in Kanata to support our programs.

Artworks will be exhibited for sale during the month of March at the Wild Oat Bakery, Café & Farm, located at 819 Bank Street, Ottawa.

- Open to all artists
- Works must be submitted in one of the following price categories: \$50, \$100, or \$200
- Maximum size: 36" width and 36" height, including frame
- Artwork must be finished and ready for professional exhibition: works on paper must be framed and protected with glass; works on canvas must be wired for hanging.
