Short title : Maple tree tapping and opening of the Sugar Shack restaurant

What :

For several decades, the tapping of our maple trees has marked the opening of the sugar season in Ottawa. Vanier is home to the only active sugar shack in an urban setting in the world. Come and take part in this typically Canadian activity, supervised by our maple producers, and enjoy a free pancake breakfast at the sugar shack!

On Sunday February 17th, the sugar shack restaurant will open for a new season. The sugar shack will be open, without reservation, every Saturday and Sunday between 9am and 2pm until 28th April. Group reservations (15 persons+) are accepted from Wednesday to Friday.

Learn more about the maple production at Vanier Museopark, or enjoy a tradition meal in a warm and authentic atmosphere.
