**Outreach Worker/Health Promoter - Early Years Program
Centretown Community Health Centre (CCHC) – 2 days/week (0.4FTE)
Fixed term part-time contract of 3months – with a possibility of extension**

The Early Years Outreach Worker/Health Promoter is a member of the Community Health Promotion Program, and works as part of the Early Years (EY) team. This role provides support to isolated, economically disadvantaged families and newcomer families with children within a designated age group who live within the Centretown Community Health Centre (CCHC) catchment area. The EY Outreach Worker/Health Promoter conducts and/or facilitates the planning, development, implementation and evaluation of age and development appropriate health promotion programs and activities at CCHC or within the community. Outreach activities include home visits, family shelter visits, community engagement, and collaboration with community and CCHC partners to deliver programming and foster community access to appropriate resources in support of healthy child growth and development.

Essential Requirements:

- Minimum of three (3) years' experience:
 - as an outreach worker/health promoter;
 - working with children and families;
 - working with diverse communities experiencing impact of social determinants of health.
- Knowledge of parenting issues and child development.
- Experience facilitating groups and utilizing adult learning techniques.
- Ability to work well with marginalized groups.
- Knowledge of health promotion principles, social determinants of health, and Model of Community Health and Wellbeing.
- Has First aid and CPR certification or willingness to obtain and maintain.
- Proficient with Windows-based computer systems, in particular, basic email and MS Word
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Ability to work well independently and as part of multi-disciplinary team.
- Excellent time management and organization skills.
- Ability to work some evenings and weekends

Desirable:

- Ability to communicate in other languages is an asset (i.e. Arabic, Somali, Chinese and Spanish)
- Ability to write in French is an asset
- Training in Early Childhood Education
- Prenatal and postnatal knowledge and experience
