

You are invited to attend the 23rd annual Almonte Fibrefest on Saturday, Sept 8, 10AM - 5PM and Sunday, Sept 9, 10AM - 4PM where local guilds will demonstrate spinning, knitting, weaving, rug hooking, lace making, smocking and quilting.

Participating as well are over 90 vendors including spinners, weavers, and fibre artists from across the province as well as quilt shops and alpaca farms.

Workshops run on Thursday through to Sunday (Sept 6–9) at both the museum and the arena, and registration fees include free admission to the festival. Advance registration is required and some workshops may need you to bring some of your own supplies, so do check out the website and sign up early.
