Job Title: Nurse Practitioner, RN (Extended Class)

Join a dynamic group of health care professionals providing a full spectrum of primary health care in a community health centre located in downtown Ottawa.

The Urban Health Nurse Practitioner works with homeless, people who use drugs, marginally housed or street affected clients to provide comprehensive primary care and help clients achieve their desired health goals. The position will have a large outreach focus, particularly in rooming houses. The role works collaboratively with other members of our Urban Health team, including other nurse practitioners, family physicians, registered nurses, diabetes educators, social workers, community support workers and other health care professionals. Knowledge and skills related to prescribing opioid agonist therapies / safer supply and experience working with people who use drugs is essential.

Requirements:

- Bachelor degree in Nursing
- Registration in the Extended Class with the College of Nurses of Ontario.
- Minimum two years experience as a Nurse Practitioner, RN (EC), preferably with community primary care outreach experience
- Current professional liability coverage
- Knowledge of and commitment to community-based health care
- Knowledge of the health needs of people who are homeless/ marginally housed
- Expertise in supporting people with complex mental health and addiction issues
- Knowledge and experience with opioid agonist therapies and/or safer supply
- Demonstrated ability to a harm reduction approach to care (experience with opioid agonist therapy/ safer supply)
- Ability to work effectively, independently and in a multi-disciplinary team setting
- Experience in case management / care coordination
- Strong clinical assessment skills
- Strong problem solving skills
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills

- Excellent interpersonal and organizational skills
- Proficient with Windows-based computer systems, in particular email and MS Word.
- Available to work occasional scheduled evenings or weekends.
