SEOCHC particularly responds to persons who face barriers to accessing health and social services and who live in South-East Ottawa. Our services and programs are designed to meet the needs of our community.

Our Primary Care clinic is seeking an experienced bilingual Registered Practical Nurse to provide support to our providers and clients. The successful candidate will work as a member of an inter-professional primary care team which includes physicians, nurse practitioners, nurses, administrative staff, and allied health professionals.

Due the pandemic, we conduct daily infection prevention screening of all clients and staff coming to our Centre to help prevent exposures to COVID-19. We provide both virtual and face-to-face visits to our clients. The successful candidate may be required to work both onsite and virtually as needed.

- Licensed and registered with the College of Nurses of Ontario in good standing.
- Demonstrated competence within the full scope of practice of a Registered Practical Nurse
- Knowledge of College of Nurses of Ontario (CNO) Standards of Practice and commitment to maintaining reflective practice standards as described by the CNO.
- Experience with Electronic Medical records would be an asset;
- Interest in application of technology in health care environment.
- Familiarity in the development of clinical services, policies/procedures and workflow processes
- Comfortable working within the healthcare environment and with health care partners.
