## PART-TIME ADVISOR

CUPW and UPCE-PSAC require part-time advisors to offer assistance, advocacy support and information to members through telephone calls and teleconferences for the Moving On Project. Advisors may contact by telephone up to 20 members, two times each year.

The successful candidates will have:

- Experience with families who have adult sons and daughters with disabilities
- Knowledge of adult services in their province or region
- Able to access information and communicate online
- Good communication and facilitation skills
- An ability to communicate in both French and English

Payment schedule varies from \$40.00 to \$75.00 per interview per member, depending on the nature of the interview.
