The North Lanark Community Health Centre, a part of Lanark Renfrew Health & Community Services, is a fully accredited health centre providing primary health care, health promotion programs and illness prevention services.

Position Summary:

This position is part of the IASP (Improving Access to Structured Psychotherapy) provincial initiative.

The psychotherapist offers brief cognitive behavioral therapy to adult clients who suffer from mental illness (mostly mood and anxiety disorders). The psychotherapist will work in collaboration with the Royal and other agencies in the Champlain area and will be required to travel to participate in training and supervision. This program may be deployed in Lanark or Carleton Place.

The psychotherapist will complete clinical work, participate in on-going training and supervision and will be required to complete all data collection related to this project and facilitate its implementation.

Qualifications:

- Masters in counselling psychology, social work, occupational therapy, nursing or psychology.
- Member in good standing with the College in Ontario regulating psychotherapy.
- Minimum of three (3) years experience with a clientele that suffers from mental health issues.
- Expertise in cognitive-behaviour therapy.
- Profound knowledge of mental illness
- Good understanding of rural issues.
- Capable of working in an inter-professional environment.
- Must hold a valid driver's license, use of vehicle and insurance.

Conditions of Employment:

- FULL TIME – 1.0 FTE (day/evening)
- Temporary position until March 31st, 2020
- One week of mandatory training will take place between August 16 to 22, 2018
