Dear Employer,

JobsFirst is a federally funded employment training program made possible by Employment and Social Development Canada. The program offers youth an opportunity to receive hands-on training and job search support. It is delivered through Operation Come Home and consists of two parts. The first being a 6 week period where participants will take part in employment related skills sessions, workshops, and certifications at Operation Come Home. The following 12 weeks will be spent working in a job placement of their choice, with the continued employment and social support from the JobsFirst staff.

Employers who choose to partner with the program will benefit by having the opportunity to hire trained, skilled workers who are hardworking, ambitious, and motivated. JobsFirst works under the Individual Placement & Support (IPS) model which focuses on finding ideal job matches based on an individual's skills and interests. Once this has been established, IPS offers the following services to ensure ongoing success of participants and employers;

- Employment support staff to work alongside both client and employer to ensure everyone's needs are met. This can include additional training, worksite visits, mediation, etc.
- Employers may be eligible for subsidies to compensate training costs and hours available through our partnership with Employment and Social Development Canada.
- Business will be featured on the Operation Come Home website, social media, and much of our promotional material as a key supporter of our participants.
